

Seasonal's Fall Camping Information 2015

If you plan to leave your trailer plugged into the power box after September 7, 2015, you will need to pay in advance for the number of days you will be plugged in. If you decide to unplug, remove the cord completely from the power box. Please clean off your plug before putting it back in the pedestal.

The Seasonal's fall **daily entrance fee** is \$5 per day per **seasonal site**, if you are at the campground or plugged into the power box. For example, if you arrive on Friday and leave on Sunday, the charge will be \$15. The \$5 is a daily fee and is not based on 24 hours. **Diamond pass holders will not need to pay the fall daily fee or worry about unplugging until October 31.**

Everyone will need to continue to drop off their trash at the trash compactor, as all waste materials will not be picked up from your campsite. Any "**uncontained**" woodpiles are not allowed. They create homes for critters.

Weather permitting: **sewer pumps** will be done weekly until Thursday, October 29th. The water will remain on (*weather permitting*) until Friday, October 30th. Please check the website, the marquee board or the office for water availability. If the weather turns to freezing, we may have to shut the water off before October 30th.

Weather permitting: **all restrooms** will remain open as long as water is available to the campsites. The restroom and laundry facility at 2nd street will be open until Saturday, October 31st as this restroom is not winterized.

When you **winterize your trailer**, remember to unplug and pick up any cords, hoses or other loose articles to prevent their loss in storms or getting caught in the mowers during the spring reopening.

Up until Friday, October 30th, mail will be delivered to your site if you have a mailbox. If you don't have a mailbox, check at the gatehouse. Mail received at the campground after Friday, October 30th will be returned to sender.

If you have a **registered boat with a 2015 boat sticker**, it may be stored on **your** lot at no additional cost. Boats cannot be stored on empty or vacant lots or on GWA parking lots. Boats left anywhere else in the campground will be removed and the owner will be charged a **minimum \$100 removal fee**. On your lot, boat storage is only for boats. Automobiles, speedboats and storage trailers are **not** permitted to be stored on your site lot.

Boats. If you prefer NOT to store your boat on your campsite for the winter, see the office for field storage. The cost is \$50.00 for the winter. There is no winter storage by the golf course. If you are currently storing something in the golf course storage area, it must be removed before Friday, October 15.

Something new! Please see the office to be certain we have a current email address on file so we may email your 2016 seasonal contract.

The curfew, quiet time and visitor's fee policies will remain in effect until Saturday, October 31st. Quiet time is 11pm and golf cart curfew is midnight. All children, including teens, must be on their lot at dark or when the streetlights come on. However, kids may use the lighted recreational courts until 11pm if accompanied by a **parent**.

The office will be open daily 8am - 8pm until October 30th. The park and office will close at 4pm on Saturday, October 31.

Starting Monday, November 2.

- The Office **only** will be open Monday through Friday from 9am-5pm for business without trailer access.
- The **office and campground** will be open on Sunday, November 1, 8, 15 and 22nd from noon to 3pm. This is for your convenience so you can check on your camper. When there is snow, only main roads will be plowed.
- The campground will **not** be open on Thanksgiving weekend or on any Sunday in December. Resuming January 10, 2016, GWA will be open every Sunday between Noon and 3 pm. **Check the GWA website or Facebook for Campground News. Thank you for your cooperation. We'll see you in the Spring!**
