Rec Center Pavilion Dances: Please remember while you're at the dances, golf carts and bicycles are to be parked in designated areas only. No smoking or drinking on the dance floor. Please note: glass bottles of any kind are strictly prohibited underneath the pavilion. **Pets are not permitted at the dances either.** All children 6 years & younger who attend the dances must be accompanied by an adult at all times. Dances begin at 7 pm and end promptly at 11pm. Take the time to clean up after yourself. ***NO Glass bottles of any kind are allowed at the rec center pavilion. There is no exception. Thank you!**

The Speed Limit is 10mph. Stop at all Stop signs. This also applies to golf carts & bikes. Please take some time to inform your family & your guests of the campground rules for everyone's safety & camping enjoyment. There is **No** riding in the back of tailgates or the truck beds. **No** bike riding after dark and there are **No** golf carts allowed on the beach at any time. The Beach closes at dusk. **QUIET TIME** is 11 pm to 8 am for everyone. - After 11 pm, no radios or loud conversations.

Campfire Safety: Fires are permitted only within the fire rings. An adult must be present at all times. Do not leave the fire unattended. Douse with water before leaving the area, because embers will stay hot for several hours afterwards.

Campfire Wood: Can be purchased at the **C & B General Store** or from the **Gatehouse** after the store has closed. For larger loads of wood, contact **King Kut** - Bill (517) 812-2455 ***No other outside wood or vendors are allowed without prior permission from the GWA office.** All outside wood brought in will be confiscated and burned onsite.

If you need a current sticker, please bring your payment and a copy of your liability insurance to the GWA office.
