911 EMERGENCY INFORMATION

- Inform 911 operator who & where you are calling from:
 - **Greenwood Acres Family Campground, 2401 Hilton Rd., Jackson, MI 49201**
- Include **your site location**. Notify the front gate (517) 522-8600 of your situation & location.
 - If possible, send someone to the front gate to guide the EMS unit to your location.

DRIVING IN THE CAMPGROUND applies to all motorized vehicles, including golf carts.

- Driver must possess a valid driver's license & be at least be 25 years of age.
- Must register vehicle(s) at office & provide proof of insurance.
- Posted speed limit is 10 mph. Please abide by it.
- Stop at all STOP signs. No passing other vehicles.
- Motorcycles & Mopeds are prohibited, **designated parking lot next to front office*
- No riding on tailgates or in truck beds. No sitting on laps.
- Each passenger requires their own seat. Skate boards, hover boards, roller blades, kid's electric cars, scooters, drones and/or other remote controlled flying objects are prohibited.

GOLF CARTS must obey 10 mph speed limit & stop signs.

- Must register at office & provide proof of insurance.
- Must be in good working order, have lights & must be quiet.
- Driver must possess a valid driver's license & be at least be 25 years of age. **(Except for Greenwood Acres' staff)...**
- **Use of golf carts are prohibited between midnight & 6 am.**
- No cutting across campsites or open areas. Stay on the roads.
- No standing on the back of the golf cart.
- Each passenger requires their own seat, including infants in car seats. No sitting on laps.
- Loud radios are prohibited or not allowed.

BOATS from Greenwood Acres are restricted to the south side of Goose Lake.

- The speed limit is 5 mph. No wake.
- Water skis, jet skis, speed boats & tubing are prohibited.
- No trespassing on any dock/boat along Goose Lake shoreline.

BICYCLES must obey stop signs.

- Even if your bike has lights, riding after dark is prohibited.
- One person to a bike unless, there is more than one seat.

CAMPFIRES & WOOD must be purchased from our store, gatehouse or an approved wood vendor to help prevent the spread of insects and diseases.

- Fires are permitted only within the fire ring.
(Do not burn garbage).
- Fires must be attended with an adult present at all times.
- Douse fires with water before leaving the area.

VISITORS must know someone camping here to visit the park.

- Must leave the park by 11:30 pm, or will be charged an overnight camping fee.
- Visitors must pay the visitor's fee -
- Visitor passes must be left at the gate upon departure.
- One visitor vehicle per lot; additional visitors may park in the designated lot near the office.
- Two (2) vehicles are included in the overnight camping fee.
- Visitors cannot walk through the gate.
- Large visitor groups must be pre-approved with the office.

CURFEW must be on your own site at curfew time.

- 6 yr. olds & younger must have an adult with them at all times.
- Children 7-11 yr. olds, **(unless accompanied by a parent)** must be on their site by 10 pm or dark, whichever comes first.
- 12 yr. olds, teenagers & singles under 25 yrs. of age, must be on their site by 10 pm or dark on week days. Midnight is their curfew during weekends and holidays.
- Every day during spring & fall camping, the curfew is the same for all, 10 pm or dark; whichever comes first.

QUIET TIME is 11 pm to 8 am for everyone.

- After 11 pm, no radios or loud conversations.
- No lawn mowing or loud power tools before 10 am.

BEACH is open during daylight hours only.

- No lifeguard on duty.
- Dogs, vehicles & glass containers are **not** permitted on the beach.
- *You may use inner tubes, floats or other appropriate water toys.*
- Tables and wooden rafts are forbidden in the lake.
- NO Fishing on the beach. The fishing pier is behind the café.

PETS must be licensed & current with all vaccinations.

- Pets must be on a 6' or less leash at all times.
- Aggressive pets are not allowed at Greenwood Acres.
- Owners are responsible for keeping their pet(s) quiet.
- Greenwood Acres reserves the right to ask any owner to remove their pet(s) at any time.
- Owners must clean up any and all pet waste.

STRICTLY PROHIBITED is hunting, weapons, violence, vandalism and fireworks. Handheld sparklers are okay-use care.
