

Spring camping information for Seasonal Campers

There are new activities, new faces and continued improvements at Greenwood Acres Family Campground. Pick up a newsletter when you come into the park, check the marquis, or check the website for activity details. Don't miss the fun!

OPENING DAY ~ Monday, April 1, 2019 at 8 am.

GATE ~ Starting April 1, 2019 there will be a 24 hour gate attendant through October 31, 2019 at 4:00pm.

DAILY FEE ~the daily fee is \$6.00 per day per site if you are here or plugged in to the electrical service. It is payable at the gatehouse or office. If you camp on Friday, stay Saturday and go home on Sunday, the fee is \$18.00. You may still get the **Diamond Pass for spring and fall before April 15, 2019.**

OFFICE ~ starting April 1, the office hours are 8 am – 8 pm daily, unless posted otherwise.

BATHROOMS ~ the bathhouse on 2nd Street will be open for your use. All other bathrooms will be closed until the weather permits us to turn on the water.

WATER ~ the water will be turned on weather permitting.

SEWER PUMPS ~ the sewer pumps will start after the water is turned on. Advance sign-up is required. See the gatehouse for advance sign-up and pricing.

CAMPFIRES ~ do not burn until water is turned on. No pallets or garbage in your campfire pit. To contain and stop the spread of diseases to trees, do not bring wood in. You may purchase wood at the campground store, front gate when store is closed, or from a campground approved wood vendor.

CONSTRUCTION ~ there will be some on-going construction projects this year. Therefore intermittent power outages are to be expected. Stay away from these construction areas. The electrical system, waste system, pool, boat dock and other facilities will be improved this season.

CURFEW ~the curfew is 10pm or dark every night until May 24th. Lighted recreation courts may be used after dark if supervised by a parent.

DANGER ~ all of our utilities are underground. Ask the office before you do any digging.

GRASS ~ only grass should be placed in the grass wagon. No bags or trash.

TRASH ~please use the trash compacter located at the "Y" by the grass wagon. There is no on-site trash pick-up.

MAIL ~if you are having mail delivered, make sure your trailer is clearly marked with your lot and street number. You will also need a mail box.

MESSAGES ~ messages will be delivered to campers from April 1st through October 31st when staff is available. Check the gatehouse or office if you haven't received expected mail.

BOATS ~ all boats must be off your lot by Memorial Day Weekend.

RULES & REGULATIONS ~keep a copy of the GWA rules and regulations in your trailer for everyone to follow. Make sure your family and guests are also aware of the rules.
