- Propane Sales at GWA:** 1 pm daily. Please pay in advance at the Gate House. All tanks have a \$3.00 fill fee that is included in the price. Pick-up and Delivery is \$10.00 per tank.
- 20 lb. Tank = \$19.00
  - 30 lb. Tank = \$27.00
  - 40 lb. Tank = \$35.00
  - 100 lb. Tank = \$83.00 total fill plus \$10.00 pickup and delivery
  - 100 lb. Tank for partial fill = pay .80 cents per pound after fill, pickup and delivery is \$10.00
