



2021 Spring Camping Information

Social distancing and masks will be required in necessary situations as stated by our local, state, and federal health officials.

Front Check-In Booth: There will be a 24/7 check-in team member on site starting April 1st at 8:00am - October 31st at 4:00pm.

2021 Seasonal Passes: will be available upon your check-in starting April 1st, 2021. To ensure this process runs smoothly, please have your liability insurance and e-signed seasonal camping agreement on file prior to your arrival. Call ahead when coming out to camp for the first time this season and we will have all of your passes ready for pick up.

Seasonal Daily Fee: If you opted out of the 2021 Diamond Pass, the "Seasonal Daily Fee" is \$8 per site, per day, starting April 1st - May 27th. Please pre-register your seasonal daily fee online or by calling our office in advance, to avoid person to person contact as much as possible.

2021 Visitor Policy:

- **Must be pre-registered by the campsite occupant 48 hours in advance. Unregistered visitors will not be granted entrance to the campground.**
- **Two visiting vehicles per site a day maximum.**
- **More than 2 visiting vehicles per site will be considered a gathering. Gatherings will require prior approval and proper facility rental. Gatherings of more than 10 persons are not permitted on 1 site.**

Office & Appointment Hours: Our operating hours and procedures are being adjusted to accommodate the health and safety of our guests and employees. The office will be closed to walk in traffic. We will assist you at your vehicle as you check in or at your campsite. We will be continuing the On-Site appointments for the 2021 Season (Call or email for appointment availability). We ask for thoughtful consideration as we continue our efforts to operate with caution.

- **Friday: 10am-8pm**
- **Saturdays (and holiday Sundays): 8am-8pm**
- **Sundays (and holiday Mondays): 8am-6pm**

Bathrooms: Our 2nd st restroom facility will be open 24hrs with water available. Self-flushing toilets and touch free faucets are now installed. Other restrooms and buildings will remain closed until after the water is turned on and they have been dewinterized. We anticipate the water will be turned on before the 15th of April, as the weather appears to be favorable.

Water: Please do not drink the water until posted safe. Our water system will be flushed, once the water is on and any repairs needed are made. A sample will then be sent in for testing. Once the test comes back as safe to drink, we will post an update.

Pump Outs: Done weekly on Thursdays. Pump outs will start after the water is turned on. Please prepay online or by calling our office no later than Wednesday at 10pm.

Propane: is filled daily at 1pm. Your tank must be at the fill station and have the prepaid receipt attached to be filled. You can prepay online, by phone, at the front check-in booth, or outside of the front office.

Wood: is available per \$5 bundle at our front check-in booth. You can schedule larger quantities to be delivered to your site by contacting a 2021 wood vendor.

Campfires: must be attended to at all times and an adequate water source must be available. No pallets or garbage in your campfire. To contain and stop the spread of diseases to trees, do not bring wood in.

Improvements: There will be some on-going construction projects this year including a new seasonal entrance, roads, and updates to our wastewater system. Please avoid construction areas, and allow the crews to work uninterrupted.

Boats: must be removed from campsites by May 27th (exception for kayaks, may be stored neatly at your campsite). Pontoon docks will be reinstalled mid April.

Grass disposal: only grass should be placed in the "Grass Wagon" located by the trash drop off. No bags or trash in the "Grass Wagon" please.

Trash Drop Off: Located conveniently near the south end of our campground for easy drop off upon departure. Our trash drop off is limited to your standard bags of trash, from your camping stay only.

Curfew: 10pm or dark every night until Friday, May 28th. Our lighted recreation courts may be used after dark with parental supervision.
