



2023 Golf Cart Policy

- 1.** All golf carts must be registered at the office. You must show proof of liability insurance and pay the registration fee. No refunds. No prorated pricing available.
- 2.** Golf cart drivers must be 25 years or older and have a valid driver's license to drive in the park. Drivers may lose their golf cart privileges if it is determined they are driving reckless or irresponsibly. Drinking and driving is not permitted.
- 3.** Golf carts must be approved by management to use in the park. No ATVs, ORVs, Gators, utility vehicles or limousine carts. Standard golf carts only. High rise carts are allowed if not extremely high.
- 4.** All golf carts must have current park registration sticker stuck on the front and center of the golf cart for easy visibility by park staff.
- 5.** All golf carts must be in good working condition with working headlights and rear reflectors after dark. Gas golf carts cannot produce excessive pollution.
- 6.** All golf carts must be quiet as determined by management. Loud radios are prohibited.
- 7.** Golf carts may accommodate only passengers for which there is a seat. Passengers must remain seated on the golf cart seats, not fenders, other passengers or golf bag holder.
- 8.** Campers may not drive golf carts between 12 midnight and 6am. Park staff may use a golf cart during this time if they are working during this time.
- 9.** Golf carts must follow the same rules as all vehicles. Stop at stop signs or crossroads. Abide by speed limit of 10mph. No passing other vehicles. Bikes, pedestrians and park vehicles have the right of way.
- 10.** Golf carts must stay on park property on marked roads or parking areas. No cutting through campsites or open fields.
