

2024 Boat Policy

 All boats must be registered with the campground and display a current season permit on the front. Registered boats may be stored on your own lot in the off season from Labor Day to Memorial Day weekend. The speed limit on the lake is 5mph. Water skiing, jet skis, speed boats, deck boats, bass boats, jet boats, etc. or tubing are not allowed. Boating is restricted to the south half of the lake. Management reserves the right to remove unregistered boats and/or docks in poor condition, unmarked or abandoned.

2. All boats including Lake Front and Canal campsites must be registered at the office to receive the current season permit for this year. In addition, you must show proof of ownership, liability insurance and have a MC License on your boat.

3. Pontoon boat slips, as well as, fishing spaces will be assigned by the office on a first come basis (pontoon slips have a waiting list which is full at this time).

4. Aluminum docks for pontoons will be shared by 2 pontoon boats. Bumpers may be purchased for \$25.00 each at the office, no personal bumpers and/or tires are allowed at our docks.

5. Fishing boat spaces can be used for up to 3 small boats such as kayaks, paddle boats, row boats and canoes.

6. You must maintain your boat slip area by keeping it mowed, trimmed and free of debris. If Greenwood Acres needs to mow or trim you will be charged \$25.00.

7. Anything not specified in the above policy must be pre-approved in writing by management.

8. Campers agree to comply with and obey federal, state, local and all other applicable laws, regulations, statutes and ordinances.

9. Campers and guests shall indemnity, defend and hold Greenwood Acres harmless from any and all claims, damages, losses, liabilities or expenses (including reasonable attorney fees and costs) arising from occupant's use of the campground and its facilities and improvements or any activity permitted or done by campers, or the invitees of campers.
