-New Wifi

-Front Check-In Booth

Overnight bookings: Check-in is 3pm or later, and checkout is by 2pm. We will be on-site 24/7 from April 1st at 8:00am to October 31st at 4:00pm. You can contact us by phone at (517) 522-8600 or by email at office@gwafc.com.

-Visitor Policy

To minimize congestion, up to 2 visiting vehicles are allowed per site. Visitors are charged daily per vehicle. Please register and approve your visitors within 48 hours of their arrival so we can ensure they are welcome. Visiting be closed for the season on Wednesday, October 15th. Oak hours end at 11:30 pm.

-Traffic Control

Must be 25 years or older to drive or operate any motorized open 24/7. transportation inside the campground (including golf carts). Sedans, SUVs, trucks, golf carts, non-motorized push-foot scooters & bicycles are permitted inside the campground. Skateboards, rollerblades, hoverboards, motorcycles, mopeds, electric or motorized scooters, and bikes are prohibited. No bike or scooter riding after dark. Please stop at all stop signs for pedestrians' safety.

-Office Hours

-Pump Outs

Done weekly on Thursdays. Pump-outs will start at \$50, and each additional valve is \$10. Please prepay online or call our office no later than Tuesday at 5 pm *no exceptions. There is a free pull-up dump station near the 2nd street restrooms for all campers. The last date for pump outs will be Thursday, October 16th.

-Propane-Fills & Exchanges

Filled daily at 1 p.m. Your tank must be at the fill station with the receipt attached. Please pay in person at the office. carts on the beach. For propane tanks to be filled, all cylinders must be in good **-9 Hole Golf Course** condition and 12 years or newer from the date of manufacture on the cylinder. After 12 years, the tank must must have your own equipment, and children 12 years old be recertified by a licensed provider. We recommend either and younger must be accompanied by an adult. Hammond Hardware or Baker's Propane. All cylinders must have an OPD valve in order to be filled. If the tank cannot be filled, you may exchange it or have it recertified. are available at the Rec Center (during opening hours). \$2 For further details and questions, please contact the Office. per Putter (includes one ball). A \$5 deposit is required. The Propane tank exchange is available anytime for 20 lb and 30 lb tanks only.

-Campfires

Must be attended to at all times, and an adequate water source for extinguishing must be available.

-Golf Carts

Standard 2 and 4-person golf carts only. A current 2025 permit is required to be in the campground & all persons must be seated. NO standing or sitting on laps. Drinking and driving is strictly prohibited. The maximum speed limit is 10 mph. All golf carts must be parked on their campsite by 12 am. You can visit our website for our full golf cart policy.

-Pets

Friendly and non-aggressive pets only. Must be kept on a 6' leash, picked up after, and attended to at all times. No fencing or kennels to contain pets. No pets at events, activities, inside facilities, or amenities. Please do not leave your pets unattended outside on your site while you are away. Must have a copy of the vaccination.

-Trash Drop Off

Located near the south end of our campground for easy drop-off upon departure. Our trash drop-off is ONLY for standard trash bags from your camping stay. Please look at our trash disposal policy on our website for full details.

-Water Shut off

The date for the water to be turned off will be Monday, October 27th *weather permitting for it to stay on that

-Restrooms

The Pool bathrooms and Basketball Court bathrooms will and Tomahawk will be closed on Monday, October 19th. The 2nd Street restroom and laundry facility will remain

-Curfew

Policies remain in effect until October 31st. Quiet time is 11 pm and golf cart curfew is midnight. All children, including teens, must be at their campsite by dark or when the streetlights come on. However, you may use the lighted recreational courts until 11 pm if accompanied by a parent.

-Jumping Pillows

Hours: Friday: 5 pm-7 pm, Saturday: 10 am-2 pm and 3pm-7 pm (or by dusk), and Sunday: 10 am-1 pm. *weather permitting* Socks are required to jump on pillows, please.

-Rec Center

Hours: Friday & Saturday 10 am-10 pm, and Sunday 10 am- 4 pm until water has been shut off throughout the campground.

Open from dawn to dusk. No pets, glass containers, or golf

Be sure to winterize your RV before we close on October 31st. When winterizing your RV, please disconnect your power cord and water hose. Pick up any cords, hoses, or other loose articles to prevent their loss and or damage.

-On Campsite Winter Storage

If you have a registered boat with a 2025 boat sticker, it may be stored on your campsite at no additional cost. Boats may not be stored anywhere other than your own campsite or registered storage space. Boats left elsewhere in the campground will be removed at the owner's expense. Vehicles & utility trailers are NOT permitted to be stored on your lot.

-Boat storage

If you prefer NOT to store your boat on your campsite for the winter, see the office for a winter storage space (Spaces Are Limited). The cost is \$200.00 for the winter.

-Power

All campers must be unplugged by October 31st. There will be a \$25 fee if the staff has to unplug them after the 31st.

-Campground Access After October 31st

Starting Sunday, November 9th, the gate will be open on Sundays from 12 pm to 3pm. (*Except for Thanksgiving through New Year*). We will resume opening on Sundays 12 pm to 3pm on January 4th, 2026.

When there is snow, only main roads will be plowed. Driving through is at your own risk.

-Camper Mail

All camper mail sent to the campground pre- and post-season will be "Returned To Sender." No camper mail will be accepted; please adjust your deliveries accordingly. Greenwood Acres is not a place of residence and may not be listed as such.
