-New Wifi

-Front Check-In Booth

Overnight bookings: Check-in is 3 pm or later, and check-out is by 2 pm. We will be on-site 24/7 from April 1st at 8:00 am to October 31st at 4:00 pm. You can contact us by phone at (517) 522-8600 or by email at office@gwafc.com.

-Visitor Policy

To minimize congestion, up to 2 visiting vehicles are allowed per site. Visitors are charged daily per vehicle. Please register and approve your visitors within 48 hours of their arrival so we can ensure they are welcome. Visiting hours end at 11:30 pm.

-Traffic Control

Must be 25 years or older to drive or operate any motorized transportation inside the campground (including golf carts). Sedans, SUVs, trucks, golf carts, non-motorized push-foot scooters & bicycles are permitted inside the campground. Skateboards, rollerblades, hoverboards, motorcycles, mopeds, electric or motorized scooters, and bikes are prohibited. No bike or scooter riding after dark. Please stop at all stop signs for pedestrians' safety. The speed limit is 10 MPH.

-Office Hours

-Bathrooms

We are renovating all of our restroom facilities. Please be cautious and courteous of the crews working to make these updates. Please be respectful of staff when they are cleaning the restrooms.

-Pump Outs

Done weekly on Thursdays. Pump-outs will start at \$50, and each additional valve is \$10. Please prepay online or call our office no later than Tuesday at 5 pm *no exceptions. There is a free pull-up dump station near the 2nd street restrooms for all campers.

-Propane-Fills & Exchanges

Filled daily at 1 p.m. Your tank must be at the fill station with the receipt attached. Please pay in person at the office. For propane tanks to be filled, all cylinders must be in good condition and 12 years or newer from the date of manufacture on the cylinder. After 12 years, the tank must be recertified by a licensed provider. We recommend either Hammond Hardware or Baker's Propane. All cylinders must have an OPD valve in order to be filled. If the tank cannot be filled, you may exchange it or have it recertified. For further details and questions, please contact the Office. Propane tank exchange is available anytime for 20 lb and 30 lb tanks only.

-Wood

Available for \$6 by the bundle at our front check-in booth. You can schedule larger quantities to be delivered to your site by contacting a 2025 wood vendor. Please, NO OUTSIDE FIREWOOD.

-Campfires

It must be attended to at all times, and an adequate water source for extinguishing must be available.

-Golf Carts

Standard 2 and 4-person golf carts only. A current 2025 permit is required to be in the campground & all persons must be seated. NO standing or sitting on laps. Drinking and driving is strictly prohibited. The maximum speed limit is 10 mph. All golf carts must be parked on their campsite by 12 am. You can visit our website for our full golf cart policy.

-Pets

Friendly and non-aggressive pets only. Must be kept on a 6-foot leash, picked up after, and attended to at all times. No fencing or kennels to contain pets. No pets are allowed at events, inside facilities, or on amenities. Vaccinations must be kept up to date with the office.

-Trash Drop Off

Located near the south end of our campground for easy dropoff upon departure. Our trash drop-off is ONLY for standard trash bags from your camping stay. Please look at our trash disposal policy on our website for full details.

-Curfew

10 pm or dark every weeknight and 12 am for kids 12 and up on weekends. Our lighted recreation courts may be used after dark with parental supervision.

-Train Hours

The Train will run on the weekends, Friday: 4 pm-8 pm, Saturday: 11 am-7 pm, Sunday: 10 am-2 pm.

-Jumping Pillows

Hours: Friday: 5 pm-8 pm, Saturday: 10 am-2 pm and 3 pm-8 pm, and Sunday: 10 am-2 pm. *weather permitting* Socks are required to jump on the pillows.

-Rec Center

Hand-dipped ice cream, arcade games, and snack bar OH MY! Hours: Friday & Saturday, 10 am-10 pm; Sunday, 10 am-4 pm. Payment is cash only.

-Store

Located at the North end of our campground, by the beach* The Store is open Sunday: 9 am-3 pm, Tuesday through Thursday: 9 am-5 pm, Friday and Saturday: 9 am-9 pm. (Closed on Mondays)

-Pool

Regular Pool hours are 10 am-8:30 pm. Adult swim is 3 pm-4 pm every day. No Lifeguard On Duty* There is a pool attendant. Must be 12 years or older or be with an adult to swim. No pets, alcohol, or glass, please. The Pool will close for the season on Monday, September 1st.

-Beach

Open from dawn to dusk. No pets, glass containers, or golf carts on the beach.

-9 Hole Golf Course

It's open daily from 8 a.m. until Dark and free to play! You must have your own equipment, and children 12 years old and younger must be accompanied by an adult.

/-18 Hole Miniature Golf Course

Open daily from 8 a.m. until Dark, and free to play! Rentals are available at the Rec Center (during Rec hours). \$2 per Putter (includes one ball). A \$5 deposit is required. The deposit will be refunded upon the return of the equipment.

-R/C Track

Open 8 a.m. until Dark. RC cars are permitted only on the track and obstacles. They are not permitted outside the designated Track. Children 11 years old and under must have an adult present. No pets or glass, please!
