



# 2026 Rules and Regulations

VISITORS must be preregistered by an on-site current camper. Must depart by 11:30 pm, If they are not departed they will be charged for an over night site fee. Limit 2 visitor vehicles per site per day.

- Visitor passes must be visible and turned in upon departure.
- Campers are responsible for their visitors, including fees due.
- Max of two visiting vehicles per site, additional visitors can park in the overflow parking.
- Visitors cannot walk in entrance gate.
- Large visitor groups must be pre-approved with the office.

## CURFEW

- 6 years old & younger must have an adult with them at all times.
- Children 7-11 years old, (unless accompanied by a parent) must be on their site by 10 pm or dark, whichever comes first. Midnight is the curfew during weekends and holidays.

\*No excessive loud noise during the day (for example, music on sites or coming from golf carts).

Quiet Time is 11pm to 8am for everyone. After 11pm, no radios, TV's music or loud conversations. No lawn mowing or loud power tools before 10am.

- Reg generators are not allowed 11:00pm-8:00am

BEACH is open during daylight hours only

- No lifeguard on duty.
- Dogs, golf carts, and vehicles are not permitted on the beach.
- Absolutely NO glass containers on the beach or in the lake.
- Tables and wooden rafts are not allowed in the lake.
- NO fishing at the beach or in the swimming area. Please fish at the fishing dock as labeled on the campground map.
- Fishing boat slips are private property and are not open for fishing.

POOL is open Memorial weekend-Labor Day 10 am-9 pm. Adult hour only every day 3 pm-4 pm No lifeguard on duty. You must be 12 years or older not to have an adult present.

DRIVING IN THE CAMPGROUND applies to all motorized vehicles, including golf carts.

- Campers are allowed 2 registered vehicles per site
- Speed limit is 10 MPH
- Must possess a valid driver's license.
- Must be at least 25 yrs. of age.
- Electric vehicles may not be charged inside the campground.
- Stop at all STOP signs. No passing other vehicles.
- No riding on tailgates or in truck beds
- Skateboards, rollerblades, motorized bikes/scooters, drones, or other remote-controlled flying objects are prohibited.

## **NO DRINKING AND DRIVING!**

GOLF CARTS must obey 10 mph speed limit & stop signs.

- Must register at office & provide proof of current insurance.
- Must be in good working order, have lights & be quiet.
- Driver must be licensed and at least 25 yrs.
- Stay on the road. No cutting across campsites.
- Must be parked at the site midnight to 6 am(except for Greenwood Acres staff).
- No standing on the back of the golf cart.
- Each passenger requires their own seat, including infants in car seats. No sitting on laps.
- Be courteous of volume control on your golf cart radio.
- 6 seater golf carts are prohibited

PETS must be licensed & current with all vaccinations.

- Pets must always be on a 6' or less leash.
- Pets are not allowed at the campground events.
- Aggressive pets are not allowed.
- Owners are responsible for keeping their pet(s) quiet.
- GWAFRC reserves the right to ask any owner to remove their pet(s) at any time.
- Owners must clean up pet waste.
- We do not allow fencing or kennels of any kind
