★ **Wood:** \$6 per bundle, available at the gate (after store hours). You can also get face and half face cords of wood delivered (upon availability) by calling one of our wood vendors.

★ **Vendors:**

★ **Ice:** \$3 per bag, available at the gate after store hours.

★ **Propane:** Partial fills pay after filling. Be certain your name, lot number and street are on the tank. There is a \$3 filling fee per tank & only tanks with OPD (Overflow Protection Device) will be refilled.

## Visitor Policy

- ★ Two visiting vehicles per seasonal site a day.
- ★ Must be pre-registered by the campsite occupant 48 hours in advance. Unregistered visitors will not be granted entrance to the campground.
- ★ More than 2 visiting vehicles per site will be considered a gathering. Gatherings will require prior approval and proper facility rental. Gatherings of more than 10 persons are not permitted on 1 site.

## Curfew

- ★ **6 yr olds and under:** Must be accompanied by an adult at all times.
- ★ **7-11 yr olds:** Must be on their site by 10 pm or dark (*whichever comes first*)
- ★ **12 yr olds, teens, & singles under 25:** Must be on their sites by 12 am on weekends and holidays (10pm or dark on non-holiday & weekdays).
