

2023 Spring Camping Information

Front Check-In Booth:

We will be on-site 24/7 starting April 1st at 8:00 am - October 31st at 4:00 pm. You can contact us by phone: at (517) 522-8600 or by email: office@gwafc.com.

Power:

Power is turned on throughout the campground as of March 24th. Campers are welcome to use the power at your campsite if it is available. Power will be restored to all campsites by April 1st at 8 am. Everything MUST be unplugged from the pedestal before leaving until April 1st.

2023 Seasonal Passes:

These will be available upon your check-in starting April 1st, 2023. To ensure this process runs smoothly, please have your liability insurance and e-signed seasonal camping agreement on file prior to your arrival.

Visitor Policy:

Visitors are charged daily per vehicle. All visitors must be pre-registered by the current campsite occupant with a 48-hour notice. Each campsite may have up to two visiting vehicles per day.

Office Hours:

Sunday-Thursday: 9 am-5 pm Friday-Saturday: 9 am-8 pm

(and holiday weekend Sundays): 9 am-8 pm

Bathrooms:

Our 2nd Street restrooms and laundry facilities will be open 24hrs with water available. Other restrooms and buildings will re<mark>main clo</mark>sed until after the water is turned on and they have been dewinterized.

Water:

the water is turned on, we will be checking the lines for leaks or repairs that need to be made, so there may be intermittent shut-<mark>offs duri</mark>ng this period. Next, we <mark>flush ou</mark>r water system and will send in a sample for testing. We will post an update as soon as we receive the results. Please do not drink the water until posted "safe to drink" after the initial turn-on date.

Pump Outs:

Done weekly on Thursdays. Pump-outs will start being offered on April 27th, 2023 (unless the weather Our long-time camper, friend, and Pool Lead, Wendy, is ready to open on May 26th. Regular Pool hours does not permit water to be on.) Please prepay online or by calling our office/check-in booth no later than Wednesday at 8 pm.

Propane:

We will fill any prepaid propane tanks at the station by the office & check-in booth daily at 1 pm. Your tank must be at the fill station and have the prepaid receipt attached to be filled. You can prepay online, by phone, in person at the office, and at the front check-in booth.

Wood:

Available by the bundle at our front check-in booth. You can schedule larger quantities to be delivered to your site by contacting a 2023 wood vendor.

Campfires:

Must be attended to at all times, and an adequate water source must be available. No pallets or garbage in your campfire. To contain and stop the spread of diseases to trees, do not bring wood in from outside of the campground and vendors.

Improvements:

There will be some construction projects this year, including our wastewater system. Please avoid construction areas, and allow the crews to work uninterrupted.

Boats:

Must be removed from campsites by Friday of Memorial weekend, AKA May 26th (exception for kayaks, they may be stored neatly at your campsite).

Grass Disposal:

Grass only should be placed in the "Grass Wagon" located by the trash drop-off. No bags or trash in the "Grass Wagon," please.

Trash Drop Off:

Located conveniently near the south end of our campground for easy drop-off upon departure. Our trash drop-off is limited to your standard bags of trash from your camping stay only.

Curfew:

10 pm or dark every night until Friday, May 27th. Our lighted recreation courts may be used after dark with parental supervision.

Jumping Pillows:

Set to open for the season starting May 20! Hours are set until June II, then will change once school is out for the summer.

Rec Center:

Opening day is Friday, April 28!. Hours (up until Memorial Weekend) will be Friday: 3pm-10pm, Saturday: IOam-IOpm, Sunday: IOam-4pm

Hours wi<mark>ll be Mon</mark>day: Closed, Tuesday-T<mark>hursday:</mark> 9am-5pm, Friday& The campground typically turns on the water to all sites on or by April 15th (weather permitting). Once Saturday: 9am-10pm, Sunday: 9am-3pm. The store will be able to sell beer and wine this season.

Starting May 12th, the Tram will be running on weekends and extended hours once school is out for the summer.
