# Front Check-In Booth:

Overnight booking check-in is 3 pm or later, and check out by 2 pm. We will be on-site 24/7 from April 1st at 8:00 am - October 31st at 4:00 pm. You can contact us by phone: at (517) 522-8600 or by email: office@gwafc.com.

# **Visitor Policy:**

To minimize congestion, up to 2 visiting vehicles are allowed per site. Visitors are charged daily per vehicle. Please register and approve your visitors so we can ensure their welcome. Visiting hours end at II:30 pm.

# Propane-Fills & Exchanges:

We will fill prepaid & registered propane tanks at the station by the office & check-in booth daily at I pm. Your tank must be at the fill station and have the prepaid receipt attached to be filled. You can prepay online, by phone, in person at the office, and at the front check-in booth. You can bring your empty tank up to exchange anytime.

#### Wood:

Available by the bundle at our front check-in booth and store. You can schedule larger quantities to be delivered to your site by contacting a 2023 wood vendor.

# Campfires:

Must be attended to at all times, and an adequate water source must be available. No pallets or garbage in your campfire. To contain and stop the spread of diseases to trees, do not bring wood in from outside of the campground and vendors.

# Golf Carts:

Must Have a Current 2023 Permit to be in the campground & all persons must be seated on a seat. NO standing or sitting on laps. Drinking and driving is strictly prohibited. The maximum speed limit is 10 mph. All golf carts must be parked on their campsite by 12 am. Please visit our website for our full golf cart policy.

Rental Pricing: Standard Two Passenger Golf Cart Rental is \$75 per day and \$450 per week Deluxe Four Passenger Golf Cart Rental \$100 per day and \$600 per week.

#### Pets:

Must be kept on a 6' leash, picked up after, and attended to at all times. No fencing or kennels are allowed. Pets are prohibited from attending events and activities. Please be mindful of your pets and those around you. Aggressive pets are not allowed inside the campground, which is strictly enforced for everyone's safety. Pets that display aggression will be required to leave the property immediately. Please do not leave your pet unattended outside on your site while you are away.

# Traffic Control:

Must be 25 years or older to drive or operate any motorized modes of transportation inside the campground (including golf carts). Sedans, SUVs, Trucks, Golf Carts, Non-motorized push-foot Scooters & Bicycles are permitted inside the campground. Skateboards, rollerblades, hoverboards, motorcycles, mopeds, and electric or motorized scooters and bikes are prohibited. No bike or scooter riding after dark. Please stop at all stop signs for pedestrians' safety.

# Grass Disposal:

Please only place grass in the "Grass Wagon" located by the trash drop-off. No bags or trash in the "Grass Wagon," please.

# Pump Outs:

Please prepay and register no later than Monday at 5 pm. Our last day for doing pump-outs will be Monday, October 16th. Please register by Sunday October 15th at 5pm.

# Trash Drop Off:

Located conveniently near the south end of our campground for easy drop-off upon departure. Our trash drop-off is limited to your standard bags of trash from your camping stay only. This has always been our policy, but we have tried to accommodate special items, and it has overwhelmed our trash drop-off services. We can no longer accept more than standard bagged camping trash items. Any other items will require prior arrangements with management and be assets for a fee. All camping trash must be brought to the trash compactor.

# Curfew:

10 pm or dark every weeknight and 12 am for kids 12 and up on weekends. Our lighted recreation courts may be used after dark with parental supervision.
