

Seasonal's Fall Camping Information 2020

Electricity-If you plan to leave your trailer plugged into the power box starting September 8, 2020 you will need to pay in advance for the number of days you will be plugged in. If you decide to unplug, remove the cord completely from the power box. Please clean off your plug before putting it back in the pedestal.

Daily fee for seasonals-The Seasonal's fall daily fee is \$8 per day, if you are at the campground or plugged into the power box. For example: if you arrive on Friday and leave on Sunday, the charge will be \$24.00. The \$8 is a daily fee and is not based on 24 hours. **Diamond pass holders will not need to pay the fall daily fee or worry about unplugging until October 31.**

Trash- Everyone will need to continue to drop off their trash at the compactor.

Pumpouts-There will **not** be any sewer pump outs for the remainder of this season. Haul your wastewater to the dump station.

Winterize your trailer before we close October 31. There will not be park access for any reason from **November 1 to November 7**. When you **winterize your trailer**, remember to disconnect your power cord and water hose. Pick up any cords, hoses or other loose articles to prevent their loss in storms or getting caught in the mowers in the spring.

Water will be turned off to the campsites on Sunday, October 25 at 4pm. The 2nd street restroom and laundry will remain open through October 31.

Free boat storage. If you have a **registered boat with a 2020 boat sticker**, it may be stored on **your** lot at no additional cost. Boats cannot be stored on empty lots, vacant lots or on GWA parking lots or fields. Boats left anywhere else in the campground will be removed and the owner will be charged a minimum \$100 removal fee. On your lot boat storage is only for boats. Automobiles, speedboats and storage trailers are **not** permitted to be stored on your lot.

Boats storage- If you prefer NOT to store your boat on your campsite for the winter, see the office for field storage. The cost is \$75.00 for the winter. There is no winter storage by the golf course. If you are currently storing something in the golf course storage area, it must be removed before Friday, October 30th.

Email- Please provide the office with a current email address so we may email your 2021 seasonal contract or send any other correspondence to you while we are closed.

Curfew and quiet time policies will remain in effect until we close, October 31st. Quiet time is 11pm and golf cart curfew is midnight. All children, including teens, must be on their lot at dark or when the streetlights come on. However, you may use the lighted recreational courts until 11pm if accompanied by a **parent**.

Office will be closed, however we will answer phones from 8am - 6pm until Saturday, October 31st. The park will close Saturday, October 31 at 4pm. **We will not be open Sunday, November 1.** You will not be allowed in the park for any reason from November 1-7. Starting Sunday, November 8, the gate will be open on Sundays from Noon to 3pm. **only.**

- The **campground** will be open on Sunday, November 8, Sunday, November 15 and Sunday, November 22nd from noon to 3pm. This is for your convenience so you can check on your camper. When there is snow, only main roads will be plowed.
- After October 31, the office will answer phone calls Monday through Friday from 9am-5pm.
- The campground will **not** be open on **Thanksgiving weekend or on any Sunday in December**. GWA will resume the Sunday noon to 3pm openings on Sunday, January 10, 2021.
